James is certainly one of the best known international postal history experts.. He also has an excellent reputation as an exhibitor, judge, author and and for the displays that he has given to philatelic societies. For his outstanding work " "Catalogue des Marques de Passage" he was awarded the Crawford Medal by the Royal Philatelic Society, London. In 2002 he was nominated as an "R.D.P. (signatory to the Roll of Distinguished Philatelists) by the RPSL.

We will update our website two or three times a week over the coming weeks with more books from the van der Linden library. There will be books on postal history from all over the world, philatelic journals and many important auction sale catalogues.
